

DIRECTIONS

Place Flea Collar around cat's neck, insert end through buckle and adjust for proper fit. Irritation to the skin may occur if collar is fastened too tightly. If collar is too long, trim off excess and discard.

When you open this pouch, you will see a fine dust of fospirate on the collar. This is normal. Do not try to remove it before putting the collar on your pet.

Activity against fleas may be observed within a few hours and will continue for up to 4 months while collar is worn. Live fleas from the premises may continue to appear on the cat but they will also be killed.

Flea Collar may be worn with regular collar. Replace Flea Collar when effectiveness diminishes.
