DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For control of insects in and around dwellings, apartment houses, office buildings, institutions, supermarkets, restaurants, food handling and processing establishments, warehouses, furniture storages, and libraries, pet quarters, and laundry trucks.

To Operate: Remove cap. Hold can upright. Aim nozzle directly at objects to be sprayed. Press valve.

NOTE: Do not use in edible products areas of food processing plants, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.

Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Flying Moths, Wasps: Close doors and windows. Direct spray upwards to all parts of the room, especially the upper corners and other areas where insects congregate. Spray 4 to 6 seconds per 1000 cu. ft. Keep room closed for at least 15 minutes after treatment. Retreat as necessary.

Roaches (except *Blattella germanica*), Crickets: Spray directly on insects where possible. Apply liberally into cracks and crevices of floors and walls, on floor coverings, under sinks, cabinets, refrigerators, in sleeping quarters of pets, and in other areas where insects breed and hide. Retreat as necessary. Do not spray directly on pets.

Fleas: Spray directly on insects where possible. Apply liberally into cracks and crevices of floors and walls, on floor coverings, under sinks, cabinets, refrigerators, in sleeping quarters of pets, and in other areas where insects breed and hide. Retreat as necessary. Do not spray directly on pets. For control of fleas, spray their fur and places where they enter the premises.

Bedbugs: Spray mattress and bedding lightly, including seams and folds. Spray bed frames, springs, pillowcases, and carpet edges, cracks, and hiding places in rooms. Allow bedding and mattress to dry before using. Apply liberally to inside walls, floors, and cracks in laundry trucks. Retreat as necessary.
