DIRECTIONS FOR USE

ZECTRAN CF-24 insecticide is recommended for application to forest lands to control larvae of spruce budworm, western spruce budworm and jack-pine budworm injurious to spruce, fir and other valuable conifers. Use 0.1 gallon of ZECTRAN CF-24 per acre (equivalent to 0.15 pound mexacarbate per acre) by diluting in sufficient deodorized kerosene or similar type oil for good spray coverage. Make the application using aerial spray equipment designed to uniformly apply the desired spray volume. Treat whenever budworm larvae are judged to be present in damaging numbers, preferably when most of the larvae are in the fourth and fifth instars. Apply only when wind velocity is less than 6 miles per hour and when other atmospheric conditions favor reduction of drift from areas treated.
