DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Place dog on a table or bench, preferably out of doors. Hold can in upright position 3-6" from the dog and thoroughly spray all over the body against the lay of the coat. Avoid spraying in eyes. Spray to leave the coat slightly damp down to skin level. Spraying time should be between 30 and 60 seconds on a medium sized dog. This can should provide 4-6 complete treatments.

One treatment will kill fleas and protect against reinfestation for up to one month. Repeat treatment as necessary. Spray bedding and sleeping area.

Free bitches from fleas before they bear pups. Do Not Use on dogs nursing puppies or on pups under 10 weeks old.

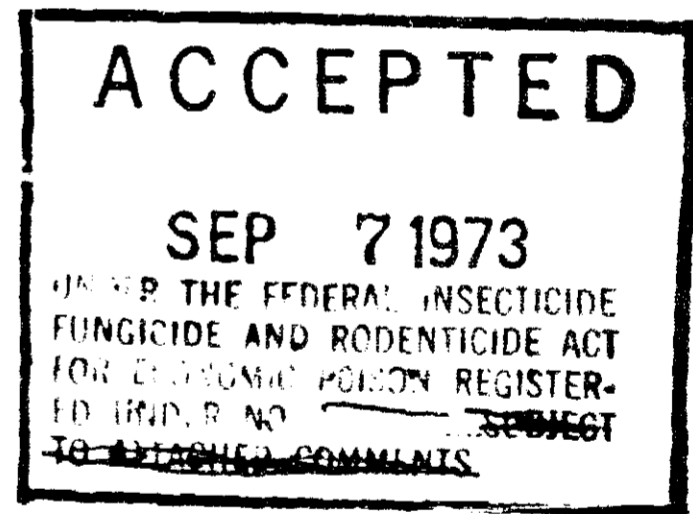

In case of eye contact, flush eyes with plenty of water. Wash hands thoroughly after using. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Do not use near fire, sparks or flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130 F may cause bursting. Use only as directed. Intentional misuse by deliberately concentrating and inhaling the contents can be harmful or fatal.

Note to Physician and Veterinarian: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine is an antidote.
