

To Control Mold and Mildew: Spray until moist and repeat weekly to prevent regrowth.

WARNING: Combustible. Do not use near fire, sparks, or flame. Do not spray in eyes. Contents under pressure. Do not puncture, incinerate, store in heat or sun as container may burst. Avoid contact with food. Before using on painted or plastic surfaces, spot test on an inconspicuous area.
