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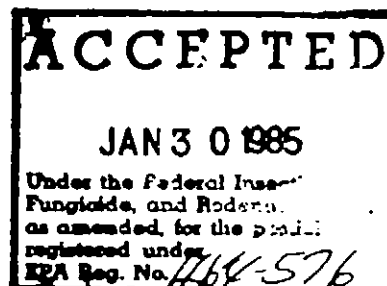

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GENERAL INFORMATION

CARLOW P Mixture Herbicide is recommended for the control of unwanted woody plants in forests, rights-of-way such as electrical power lines, communication lines, pipelines, roadsides, and railroads and on non-crop areas including industrial manufacturing and storage sites and fence rows.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

BASAL BARK TREATMENT

In rights-of-way, other non-crop areas and forests, use 1 to 2 gallons of CARLOW P Mixture Herbicide in enough diesel oil, No. 1 or No. 2 fuel oil or kerosene to make 100 gallons of spray mixture. To obtain

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the best control of hard-to-control species, such as ash and elm, or trees with diameters larger than 4 inches, use the higher recommended rate. Basal treatments are less effective on trees with diameters larger than 6 to 8 inches. Apply with knapsack sprayer or power spraying equipment using low pressure (20-40 psi). Spray the basal parts of brush and tree trunks to a height of 12-15 inches from the ground. Thorough wetting of the indicated area including the root collar is necessary for good control. Spray until run-off at the ground line is noticeable. For root suckering species such as aspen, sassafras and locust, also spray the ground under the plants to cover small root suckers which may not be visible above the soil surface. Rough bark requires more spray than smooth bark. Apply at any time, including the winter months, except when snow or water prevent spraying to the ground line. Best control will be obtained when applications are made during the late dormant or active growing season.

For oil-water mixture application, mix 2 to 3 gallons CARLON P Mixture Herbicide, 22 to 23 gallons of oil and 1 gallon of Sponto 712, or equivalent and add to 74 gallons water as directed below. Use the application procedures specified above. For best results with oil-water mixtures, treat only stems 2 inches or less in diameter.

Mixing Oil Sprays: Use only diesel oil, No. 1 or No. 2 fuel oil or kerosene. Add CARLON P Mixture Herbicide to the required amount of oil in the spray tank or mixing tank and mix thoroughly. If this mixture stands over 4 hours, reagitiation is required.

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Mixing Oil-Water Sprays: First, premix the GARLON P Mixture Herbicide, oil and surfactant in a separate container. Do not allow any mixtures containing water to get into the GARLON P Mixture Herbicide or the premix. Fill the spray tank about half full with water, then slowly add the premix with continuous agitation and complete filling the tank with water. Continue moderate agitation.

Note: If the premix is put in the tank without any water, the first water added may form a thick "invert" (water in oil) emulsion which will be hard to break.

USE PRECAUTIONS

Apply this product only as specified on this label.

Do not apply or otherwise permit GARLON P Mixture Herbicide or its spray mist to contact soil used to grow desirable, susceptible plants. Do not allow GARLON P Mixture Herbicide to contact susceptible plants such as grapes, tobacco, vegetable crops, flowers or other desirable broadleaf plants. Coarse sprays are less likely to drift. Do not apply with hollow cone-type insecticide nozzle or other nozzles that normally produce a fine droplet spray.

Untreated trees occasionally are affected by root uptake of herbicide leached into the soil or excreted by the roots of nearby treated
