The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below:

- to revise the "first aid" per PR Notice 2001-1

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

1. Under the "First Aid" Statement add the following:

For Toxicity Category I eye and skin irritants, use the following "Note to Physician".

"Note to Physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage".
2. Under the Precautionary Statements revise "Hazard to Humans" to read: "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals".
3. Under the Environmental Hazards Statement revise the first sentence to read: "This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms".
4. Delete the "s" on the word "Ingredients" in the Ingredient Statement.
5. Center the signal word "DANGER" underneath the phrase "Keep Out of Reach of Children".

6. Revise "Pesticide Storage and Disposal" to read "Storage and Disposal".
