The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under section of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable with comments.

Proposed Amendment:

• Revised labeling per EPA letter dated December 12, 2008

Labeling Comments:

The following label revisions must be made:

- 1. In the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section revise the sentence "... after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using the restroom or using tobacco."
- 2. The First Aid Statement must be reordered to read: IF IN EYES, IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING, IF SWALLOWED AND IN INHALED, per PR Notice 2001-1, according to the most toxic to least toxic route of exposure.
- 3. In the Note to Physician as per PR 2000-5 Mandatory and Advisory Language delete "should" and replace with "must" in the last sentence.
- 4. Under the Directions for Use revise sentence to read: "This product is to be used... as per PR 2000-5 Mandatory and Advisory Language.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

The decision of whether to induce vomiting or not should be made by a physician. If lavage is performed, suggest endotracheal and/or esophageal control. Danger from lung aspiration must be weighed against toxicity when considering emptying the stomach. Respiratory symptoms, including pulmonary edema, may be delayed. Persons receiving significant exposure should be observed 24-48 hours for signs of respiratory distress. Maintain adequate ventilation and oxygenation of the patient. Chemical eye burns may require extended irrigation. Obtain prompt consultation, preferably from an ophthalmologist. If burn is present, treat as any thermal burn, after decontamination. No specific antidote. Treatment of exposure should be directed at the control of symptoms and the clinical condition of the patient.
