The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with conditions.

Proposed Amendment

• Label Amendment: Adding additional use patterns (paper and paperboard; coatings for paper and paperboard)

Conditions

Revise Label to Read:

- 1. On the front page of your label, delete the word "ONLY" from the Industrial Use statement.
- 2. Revise your "Precautionary Statements" to be in agreement with the Orthopenol salts RED and label review manual by stating the following:

DANGER. Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Do not get in eyes, or skin, or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Wear goggles or faceshield, protective clothing, and chemical resistant gloves when handling. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Thoroughly was hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using toilet.

A stamped label with conditions is enclosed for your records. Submit a copy of your final printed label before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.

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ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store between 7C (45F) and 38C (100F). Keep container tightly closed when not in use. If frozen product separates, thaw completely at room temperature and stir thoroughly.

Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse or pressure rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

Option to use for labels on refillable rigid tote containers

Refillable container. Refill this container with pesticide only. Do not reuse this container for any other purpose. Cleaning of the container before final disposal is the responsibility of the person disposing of the container. Cleaning before refilling is the responsibility of the refiller. To clean container before final disposal, empty contents into application equipment and triple rinse. Pour or pump rinsate into application equipment or rinsate collection system. ADHESIVES

To protect adhesives based on starch, protein, natural and synthetic gums, and natural and synthetic rubber latex from deterioration during manufacture, storage and service life; add 0.1 to 3.0% by weight of DOWICIDE 25L Antimicrobial to the formulation.

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LATEX

To preserve synthetic and natural latex dispersions and emulsions in manufacture, transportation and storage, add 0.1 to 1.0% by wt of DOWICIDE 25L Antimicrobial to the dispersion or emulsion.

PAINTS

For preservation of decomposable raw material solutions or dispersions during paint manufacturing or storage. For shelf preservation of water-based paints. Add 0.04 - 1.6% by weight of DOWICIDE 25L Antimicrobial at a suitable point in the manufacture or storage of the paint or paint raw material.

CONSUMER, HOUSEHOLD AND INSTITUTIONAL PRODUCTS

To inhibit bacterial spoilage during the production and shelf life storage and use of consumer, household and institutional products, including dishwashing liquids, surfactants, surface cleaners, fabric softeners, laundry cleaners and polishes. Dose at 0.1 to 0.8 lb per 100 lb (1000 to 8000 ppm).

SLURRIES AND DISPERSED PIGMENTS

To control the growth of fungi and bacteria in aqueous-based slurries and dispersed pigments such as clay, kaolin, calcium carbonate, calcium sulfate, barium sulfate, magnesium silicate, iron oxide, carbon black, titanium dioxide, kieselguhr, starch, organic dyes and other filler suspensions; add 0.04 - 1.6% by weight of DOWICIDE 25L Antimicrobial at a suitable point during the manufacture, container loading/filling or shipment of the slurry.

CONCRETE ADMIXTURES

To control the growth of fungi and bacteria in concrete admixtures, add 0.1 - 1.0% by weight of DOWICIDE 25L Antimicrobial at a suitable point during the manufacture of the admixture.

METALWORKING FLUIDS

To control the growth of fungi and bacteria in metalworking fluids, add 1.0 - 2.5 gallons of DOWICIDE 25L Antimicrobial to 1000 gallons of diluted metalworking fluid. DOWICIDE 25L Antimicrobial may also be used in metalworking fluid concentrate at levels sufficient to yield 0.12 - 2.4% DOWICIDE 25L Antimicrobial in the fluid as diluted for use.

PAPER AND PAPERBOARD

This product is used to control growth of microorganisms which may cause discoloration, odor and degradation of paper and paperboard.

DOWICIDE 25L Antimicrobial may be applied to the paper making system at any point of uniform mixing. Preferably, DOWICIDE 25L Antimicrobial will be added to the finished paper at the calendar stack water box. DOWICIDE 25L Antimicrobial may be mixed into the bath at levels of 0.1% to 3.0% and may be adjusted depending on the system variables such as wet pick-up. Apply product based on the total dry weight of the paper or paperboard.

WATER BASED COATINGS FOR PAPER AND PAPERBOARD

Note: For use in non-food contact coatings only.

Formulations of DOWICIDE 25L Antimicrobial may be applied to paper and paperboard by a suitable application method immediately after manufacturing, to provide antimicrobial protection of the finished paper. Add 0.1 to 3% DOWICIDE 25L Antimicrobial based on the total dry weight of the paper or paperboard.
