The amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A), to amend the product labels to include additional pest claims and other labeling changes, is acceptable, provided that you:

- 1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec.3(c)(5) and sec. 4 when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
- 2. Delete any reference to the Food and Mouth Disease Virus (FMDV) claim until you have submitted the requested Confirmatory Efficacy Data as outlined in the Agency letter dated July 2, 2001. The request for a time-limited amendment for the Foot and Mouth Disease Virus claim is not acceptable. Please note that this claim has been blacken on the product label. Refer to the enclosed Efficacy Review for any additional comments and deficiencies found under "CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS" in regard to item #2.
- 3. Refer to the enclosed Efficacy Review, page 3 of 6 item #II, for additional use directions under the headings "For the use against the Foot and Mouth Disease Virus and "For Sanitizing Non-Food Contact Surfaces".
  - 4. On the proposed label, change "Corona virus" to "Coronavirus".
  - 5. Submit two (2) copies of final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the "accepted" labeling is enclosed for your records.

Therefore, unless the storage tank is inside or underground, heating and insulation may be required. If heating is needed, exposure to high temperatures should be avoided. For short storage times (up to about 1 month), temperatures of up to 37.8°C can be tolerated but the preferred maximum storage temperature is about (28.7°C).

A stainless steel centrifugal purrip is suggested for transfer service. Spiral wound stainless steel with TEFLON® is suitable for gaskets and packing.
