## AS A DISINFECTANT, DEODORANT, STAIN REMOVER or CLEANSER

First remove starch or dressing from white cotton and linen garments by soaking in cold water. Make a solution of two tablespoons of Launder Maid Bleach to one quart of cold water — mix well. - 1. Scrape and prewash utensils and glasses whenever possible.
- 2. Wash with a good detergent or compatible cleaner.
- 3. Rinse with clean water.
- 4. Sanitize in a solution of 1 ounce to 2 gallons of water (200 p.p.m.). Immerse all utensils for at least two minutes or for contact time specified by governing sanitary code.
- 5. Place sanitized utensils on a rack or drain board to air dry.


