

DO NOT USE ON SILK, WOOL, LEATHER, ACETATE, ORLON, DACRON, RAYON, NATURAL SPONGE OR UNFAST COLORS.

AS A DISINFECTANT, DEODORANT, STAIN REMOVER or CLEANSER

REFRIGERATORS, BASINS, BATHTUBS, FLOORS: Wash thoroughly — keep wet with solution of 3 tablespoons of Eisner Bleach to each quart of water. Let stand 5 minutes — rinse-dry.

DISHES, GLASSWARE, POTS, JARS: Use same as above — except use only 1 tablespoon of Eisner Bleach to each quart of warm water. Rinse thoroughly with clear water before use.

TOILET BOWLS: Wash-flush-pour 1 cup (8 ounces) of Eisner Bleach into bowl, apply solution over all inside surfaces, add one ounce of vinegar and let stand one hour or overnight.

SWIMMING POOLS: Amount Eisner Bleach required depends on bathing load and other factors. Sufficient Eisner Bleach solution should be used daily. Eisner Bleach can be poured directly into the Swimming Pool or fed through mechanical Chlorinators. To each 1,000 gallons water, use 5 oz. Eisner Bleach. If bathing load is heavy or day is hot, give dosage in morning and again in evening. Maintain chlorine residual of 0.6 to 1 ppm. Use test kit. Maintain the pH of the water in the 7.2 to 7.6 range or in accordance with recommendations of the local Health Authority.

SICK ROOM DISINFECTANT: To disinfect and deodorize urinals, sputum cups and rubber goods, wash-immerses in solution of 3 tablespoons of Eisner Bleach to each quart of hot water — let stand 5 minutes — rinse-dry.

TO REMOVE SPOTS AND STAINS — SUCH AS INK, WINE, BERRY, NICOTINE, COFFEE, GRASS, FRUITS, SCORCH, TEA, BLOOD, IODINE, MILDEW

First remove starch or dressing from white cotton and linen garments by soaking in cold water. Make a solution of two tablespoons of Eisner Bleach to one quart of cold water — mix well. Immerse fabric completely and soak from 10 to 15 minutes — rinse in clear water. Should any sign of mildew remain, allow it to dry in sunlight. Any remaining brown spots usually vanish with vinegar or lemon juice.

RESTAURANTS, TAVERNS, SODA FOUNTAINS, DAIRIES, ETC.

1. Scrape and prewash utensils and glasses
2. Wash with a good detergent or compatible cleaner.
3. Rinse with clean water.
4. Sanitize in a solution of 1 ounce to 2 gallons of water (200 p.p.m.). Immerse all utensils for at least two minutes or for contact time specified by governing sanitary code.
5. Place sanitized utensils on a rack or drain board to air dry.

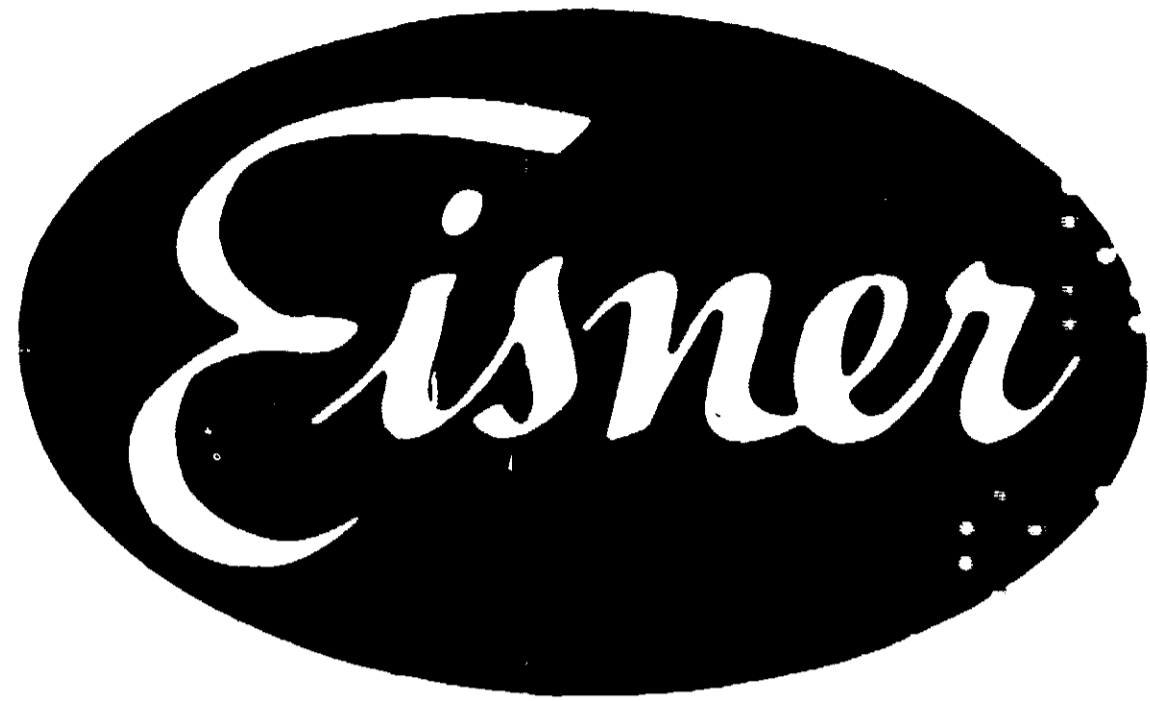

**LAUNDERING IN TUB, WASHING
MACHINE or AUTOMATIC WASHER**

Eisner Bleach bleaches white cotton, linen and nylon; brightens color-fast cotton and linen; disinfects, deodorizes, removes dingy grayness and stains. Eisner Bleach is especially valuable for laundering articles subject to germ contamination, such as diapers.

WHITE COTTONS AND LINENS Eisner Bleach is best used in First Rinse after washing — add one tablespoon (½ oz.) of Eisner Bleach for each gallon of warm water, then immerse clothes for 15 min. — rinse in cold water.

For Automatic Washers — mix one ounce of Eisner Bleach for each gallon of water and pour slowly at wash period.

In Soak suds, add 1 tablespoon Eisner Bleach for each gallon cold or warm water, mix well, add soap or sudsing powder, immerse clothes ½ hour to overnight.

BABY'S LAUNDRY Use same as above. Diapers, sheets and rubber garments laundered with Eisner Bleach are hospital clean and fresh smelling.

FAST COLORED GARMENTS Use only ½ table-
spoon Eisner Bleach for each gallon of water.
