DIRECTIONS For the control of grasses and some broadleaved weed species, such as smooth and hairy crabgrass, green foxtail, yellow foxtail, lovegrass, witchgrass, carpetweed, common chickweed. lambsquarters, purslane and Florida pussley, HENRY FIELD'S GARDEN WEEDER is recommended at the rate of 2 pounds per 500 square feet, or 1 pound (approximately 1 quart) for 250 square feet. 
