ANTROL ANT SYRUP kills sweet and certain grease eating ants. Worker ants carry Antrol back to the nest for food, often destroying the entire colony.

DIRECTIONS: Use Antrol Syrup in special Antrol Ant Killer bottles or pour small amount on pieces of cardboard. Place the prepared feeders outside of the house, close to the foundation, not over 15 to 20 feet apart. Indoors, place in areas inaccessible to children and pets.
