SNAROL PELLETS are a specially prepared bait for the control of snails and slugs. The Metaldehyde in SNAROL PELLETS attracts and kills shalls and slugs. These pests are night feeders and inhabit damp, cool places such as flower and vegetable gardens, around fences, hedges and bushes. The presence of sharts and slugs can be determined by their shiny mucous-like raits


SPREAD DIRECTIONS
SNAROL PELLETS late in the day, before or after thoroughly wetting the areas likely to be in-fested Care should be taken, when SNAROL PELLETS, to apply them to the soil and not directly on plants.

For cabbage, melons, carrots, cellary kale, peas, beans, corn, tomatoes; apply to soil surface around plants. Do not contaminate edible parts. Etr stranberries, do not would thin 5 days of harvesting.

Continuous watering and high tem Pratures cause SNAROL PELLETS gradually to lose some of their ef schiveness, so during spring and commer months repeat treatment every week or ten days. Such receated treatment will also serve to control new broods emerging durng this period. Three baitings, ten The similars, usually gives control of the hatch. During fall and winter, treatment every 2 weeks is usually satisfactory
