### KILLS SNAILS&SLUGS

SNAROL PELLETS are a socially prepared bait for the control of snails and slugs. The Metaldehyde in SNAROL PELLETS attracts and kills snails and slugs. These pests are night feeders and inhabit damp, cool places such as flower and vegetable gardens, around fences, hedges and bushes. The presence of snails and slugs can be determined by their shiny mucous-like trails.

### **DIRECTIONS**

Spread SNAROL PELLETS late in the day, before or after thoroughly wetting the areas likely to be infested. Care should be taken when spreading SNAROL PELLETS, to apply them to the soil and not directly on plants.

For cabbage, melons, carrots, celery, kale, peas, beans, corn, tomatoes; apply to soil surface around plants. Do not contaminate adible parts. For strewbergler, do not use within 6 days of harvesting.

Continuous watering and high temperatures cause SNAROL PELLETS gradually to lose some of their effectiveness, so during spring and summer months repeat treatment every week or ten days. Such repeated treatment will also serve to control new broods emerging during this period. Three baitings, ten days apart, usually gives control of new hatch. During fall and winter, treatment every 2 weeks is usually satisfactory.
