HOW CAN I BE CERTAIN I HAVE SNAILS OR SLUGS?

Look for signs of their presence in the garden. They will be found on plants, especially on the underside of leaves, and on the soil surface.

HOW DOES SNAROL WORK?

SNAROL is a natural substance which kills snails and slugs by acting on their nervous system.

WHERE DO I USE SNAROL?

Use SNAROL in the garden, on lawns, and on paths.



WHEN DO I USE SNAROL?

Use SNAROL when you first see signs of snails or slugs in the garden.



HOW OFTEN SHOULD I USE SNAROL?

Use SNAROL every 7-10 days, or after heavy rain, to keep snails and slugs under control.

One pound of SNAROL PELLETS is sufficient to treat about 1000 sq. ft. of surface area. SNAROL is also available in MEAL form.

DIRECTIONS

Spread SNAROL PELLETS in the day before or after thoroughly watering the area likely to be infested. Care should be taken when spreading SNAROL PELLETS to apply it to the soil and under plants. Do not apply directly on plants.

For cabbage, melons, carrots, celery, and peas, use a corn cobs, apply to soil surface around plants. Do not use for lettuce, asparagus, and strawberries. Do not use within 6 days of transplanting.

Continuous watering and high temperatures cause SNAROL gradually to lose some of its effectiveness. Soaking spring and summer months requires re-treatment every week or ten days. Touch treated treatment will also serve to control new grubs emerging during this period. Three baiting treatments using 1/2 lb. per 1000 sq. ft. will control grubs during the summer months. Every 2 weeks is usually satisfactory.
