Subject: Revised Labeling
Black Flag Liquid Ant & Roach Killer with Baygon and DDVP
EPA File Symbol 475-138
Your Submission Dated October 30, 1991

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. The statement "For Household Use Only" must appear on the front panel.
2. Delete the word "resistant" throughout the labeling. This term is unacceptable unless you can provide comparative efficacy data supporting such claim.
3. Delete "or paint" under Directions for Use. This method of application is unacceptable for homeowner use since it would require transfer of the pesticide from the spray bottle to a separate unlabeled container for painting. The Agency discourages the indoor use of pesticides by a homeowner that are not ready to be applied from the original, labeled container.

Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Spray or paint surfaces until damp. Thorough applications produce a coating which will vaporize into cracks and crevices and into the room for insect control. If reinfestations occur, repeat applications as necessary.

1. Roaches, resistant roaches, palmetto bugs, waterbugs, crickets, centipedes, silverfish, firebrats, scorpions and spiders. Thoroughly spray cracks and crevices around baseboards, kitchen shelves, cupboards, sinks, and refrigerators; around garbage containers; and around points of entry such as window frames.
2. Ants, Clover Mites, Sowbugs and Earwigs: Spray door sills, window frames, outside foundations and porches. Spray directly on ant hills and on swarming ants outdoors.
3. Flies, Mosquitoes, gnats, and Wasps: Apply on screens, walls, door and window frames, light fixtures and other outdoor surfaces where insects congregate.
4. Paper Nest Wasps and Mud Dauber Wasps: Apply a wet spray to the nests after dark when all pests have returned to their nests.
5. Brown Dog Ticks: Thoroughly spray cracks and crevices where pets normally lie down. Do not spray on pets. Allow the sprayed areas to dry thoroughly. Replace bedding before permitting use by animals. For dog kennels, apply to outside runways window sills and ledges.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist and contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Do not use as a space spray. Do not apply to humans, pets or contaminate feed, food stuffs, dishes or utensils. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after use. Remove birds and cover fish bowls when spraying. Do not allow children or pets on treated area until dry. Keep out of reach of children.

Statement of Practical Treatment

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. **DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING.** Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Solvent represents aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. Product contains an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

FLAMMABLE. Do not use or store near fire, sparks or heated surfaces. Do not smoke while using. Avoid excessive wetting of plastic, vinyl, or asphalt tile floor surfaces.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store in a cool place not above 100 F.

Disposal: Replace cap, wrap empty container and put in trash collection.
