1. For the product labeling of both of the pesticides cited above, add a STORAGE AND DISPOSAL section per PR Notice 83-3.


STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap, securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper, and discard in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate container.

2. The PHYSICAL HAZARDS section of the product labeling is acceptable until a new policy is established regarding the flammability statement issue.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. SPRAY ONLY IN UPRIGHT POSITION.

Lift off protective tab. Point valve opening away from your face. Hold container upright at a distance of at least 4 ft. from all plants and objects to be sprayed. Press button firmly to spray.

TO KILL HOUSE PESTS.

FLYING INSECTS—Flies, Mosquitoes, Flying Moths, Gnats, Wasps and Hornets: Spray insects directly for faster action. To clear a room, close doors and windows, spray entire room until well misted 16 to 7 seconds for average 10x12 room. Vacate room for at least 15 minutes and aerate before re-entering.

CRAWLING INSECTS—Roaches and Waterbugs Spray directly on insects where possible. Spray into hiding places, in cracks, on baseboards, under sinks, under stairs, around door sills, pipes, storage and refuse areas.

ANTS: Spray ants, ant trails, nests and points of entry

FOR GARDEN PESTS.

Kills sucking insects: Aphids, Two Spotted Mites, exposed Thrips, Lace Bugs and Leafhoppers.

Kills chewing insects: Climbing Cutworms, Southern Armyworms, Mexican Bean Beetles, Japanese Beetles (when sprayed directly)

Spray with slow sweeping motion about 4 ft. from all plants. Avoid Wetting—Spray in short bursts where necessary. Spray garden plants only when air is still. Repeat application if necessary. Do not spray in direct sunlight or during heat of day. Spray carefully on young foliage and new growth.

Spray is applicable to: Roses, Dahlias, Chrysanthemums, Geraniums, Asters, Azaleas, Gladioli, Camellias, Delphinium, Evergreens, Deciduous Shrubs and other outdoor and indoor plants.

OUTDOOR AREAS: Spray a fine mist when air is quiet to reduce Mosquitoes, Flies and Gnats during picnic times. Avoid spraying directly on food.

Precautionary Statements

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Caution: Avoid breathing of spray mist or contact with eyes and skin. Wash after use. Cover or remove exposed foods. Avoid contamination of cooking utensils and food processing surfaces. Remove pets, fish bowls and bird cages from rooms to be treated.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is highly toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, bays, marinas, and potholes). Drift from treated areas may be hazardous to organisms in adjacent aquatic sites.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS
