PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. May cause eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after using and before eating or smoking. Do not spray on humans or pets. Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs. Food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Remove birds, pets and cover or remove fish aquariums before spraying.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed: Drink one or two glasses of water. DO NOT induce vomiting because of aspiration hazard. Call physician or Poison Control Center immediately.
If on skin: Wash thoroughly with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
If in eyes: Flush eyes thoroughly with large amounts of water. Call physician if irritation persists.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates. Drift and runoff may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in neighboring areas. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, bays, marshes and potholes). Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS

Avoid excessive wetting of plastic, vinyl or asphalt tile floor surfaces. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not smoke while using.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE: Store in a cool place away from children.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Replace cap, wrap in several layers of newspaper and put in trash collection.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES AND GNATS: Where there is a heavy concentration of insects (like a room full of flies and mosquitoes) and a quick knockdown is desired, close room and spray upwards in all directions and directly on insects where possible. Vacate room for at least 10 minutes and aerate before re-entering. For Use on Screens, liberally spray inside and outside surfaces and around windows and door frames and on adjacent walls. In Outdoor Areas, spray porches, patios and garages on various surfaces where insects tend to congregate. Spray garbage cans inside and outside. Repeat treatment as necessary.

ROACHES: Spray thoroughly around base of doors and windows under and behind sinks, pipes, drawers, refrigerators. Roaches are particularly hard to control. Spray directly on insects where possible. Repeat treatment as necessary.

BEDBUGS: Using a sprayer thoroughly treat bedsteads, slats, springs, baseboards and wall cracks. Spray only tufts & seams of mattresses. Allow to thoroughly dry before use.
