DIRECTIONS: Remove spits, food and cover from room before spraying. SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. Remove spits from table, flush bottles & spray.

FLYING INSECTS:

TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS: Spray directly on flying insects for fast action. For close insects from walls, close windows and doors, spray upward with sweeping motion until room is thoroughly misted. Vacuum room for at least 15 minutes and avoid re-entry to entering.

CRAWLING INSECTS:

TO KILL ROACHES, WATERBUGS, ANTS, SPIDERS, CENTIPEDES: Spray directly on insects where possible and into cracks and crevices.

ANTS: Spray ants, ant trails and entry points.

FOR RESIDUAL ACTION AGAINST ROACHES:

Hold container 12 inches from surface to be sprayed (walls, baseboards, around pipes, under refrigerators and sinks) and spray at the rate of 12 inches (linear foot) per second, or until surface is wet. Repeat applications as necessary.

FOR RESIDUAL ACTION AGAINST FLIES:

SCREEN SPRAY: Spray door and window screens to help control insects attracted to light-flies, mosquitoes, flying moths and gnats.

GARDEN INSECTS:

TO KILL APHIDS, RED SPIDER MITES, JAPANESE BEETLES AND TENT CATERpillars: Spray outdoor flower and ornamental plants such as Roses, Chrysanthemums, Azaleas, Evergreens, Asters and Deciduous Shrubs. Hold container 3 feet from plants and spray in a sweeping motion when the air is still. Avoid wetting plants. Spray short bursts where necessary, especially on new growth. Avoid use in direct sunlight.

AREA SPRAY:

Mist outdoor areas when air is quiet to reduce Mosquitoes, Flies, and Gnats during picnic time. Avoid spraying food.

CAUTION: Keep out of reach of children. Do not spray toward face. Do not spray on humans or pets. Cover or remove exposed foods when spraying. Do not contaminate fish ponds. Spray ornamentals from 4 to 6 feet away.

WARNING: Contents under pressure. Do not store or use near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to sunlight or temperature above 120°F. may cause bursting. Avoid Freezing-Spray only in upright position.

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS: Pyrethrins 0.30%, Technical Piperonyl Butoxide 1.50% (equivalent to 1.20% (butylcarbyl) (6-propyl-piperonyl) ether and 0.30% related compounds), Petroleum Distillates 4.20%.

INERT INGREDIENTS: 94.00%.
