DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from children.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.

- To kill ANTS: Sprinkle powder around wherever Ants are found, in cracks, crevices and other hiding places. Avoid contamination of food. Apply freely across Ant trails or where pests are entering the house. Sprinkle the powder in and around the entrances of Ant hills. Do not use in wet places. Repeat as often as necessary.
- To kill ROACHES: Sprinkle powder on baseboards, in cracks and crevices, behind cupboards, sinks, refrigerators and places where roaches hide. Do not sprinkle on shelves or in drawers containing food or food handling utensils.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Do not get on skin, in eyes, or on clothing. Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants. Powder should be placed in areas inaccessible to children and pets. Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs. Wash with soap and water after use. Do not use on plants or in wet areas. Avoid breathing dust.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger, or, if available, by administering syrup of ipecac. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Atropine is antidotal.

If in eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water.

If on skin: Wash thoroughly with soap and water.
