



ROACH KILLER SPECIAL CITY FORMULA

With pinpoint spray to reach into cracks and crevices.

Contains ingredients for fast, long killing action. Keeps killing up to 28 days. Effective against roaches. Contains DDVP for vaporizing and penetrating action back of walls.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Use only as a surface spray. Shake before using. Hold container in upright position while spraying. Point valve opening toward cracks and crevices and other surfaces to be sprayed and press button firmly. Keep container in upright position 6 to 12 inches from surfaces and spray at the rate of 1 foot per second or until surfaces are wet. If re-infestations occur, repeat application as necessary.

FOR HOUSEHOLD USE ONLY

ROACHES, WATERBUGS, CRICKETS, CENTIPEDES, SPIDERS AND EARWIGS: Spray in hiding places such as cracks, along baseboards, under sinks and other places where insects hide. Spray bugs directly when they are driven out by the spray. Repeat as necessary.

ANTS: Spray ants, ant trails and their nests. Spray around doors and windows where ants enter. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap empty container and put in trash collection. Do not incinerate empty container.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist and contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Do not apply to humans and pets or contaminate feed, foodstuffs, dishes and utensils. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after use and before eating or smoking. Remove birds and cover fishbowl when spraying. Do not use as a space spray. Do not allow children on treated areas until surfaces are dry.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

CAUTION: FLAMMABLE. Contents under pressure. Do not store or use near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to sunlight or temperature above 120° may cause bursting.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed—Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING unless other treatment is not available. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. If it is necessary to induce vomiting, give victim one or two glasses of water and insert finger in back of throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled—Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If on skin—Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected area with soap and water.

If in eyes—Flush eyes for at least 15 minutes with water. Get medical attention immediately.
