The extra strength dual-purpose spray for use indoors and outdoors. Residual action keeps killing flies and roaches for weeks.

FLYING INSECTS—FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS

INDOORS: Spray flying insects directly for fast action. To clear a room, close doors and windows. Spray 6-8 seconds from center of room (3 feet from all surfaces), until thoroughly misted. Vacate room for 15 minutes and aerate before re-entering. For **LONG-LASTING ACTION AGAINST FLIES** (up to 15 days), spray screens at a 45° angle from a distance of one foot at the rate of 1 foot per second. Thoroughly spray the entire screen. Spray from both sides for better results. Reapply to screens after exposure to rain.

OUTDOORS (PATIO USE): Mist areas when air is quiet to reduce annoying insects during picnic time. Spray shrubbery and other resting areas. Avoid spraying food.

CRAWLING INSECTS—ROACHES, WATERBUGS, ANTS, SPIDERS, CENTIPEDES

Spray into cracks and crevices to flush out roaches. For quick action spray crawling insects directly. Then also spray ant trails, points of entry and ant nests when possible. For **LONG-LASTING ACTION TO KILL ROACHES AND WATERBUGS** (up to 21 days), hold container 12 inches from surfaces to be sprayed (cracks, baseboards, around pipes, under refrigerators, sinks and hiding places). Spray at the rate of 6 inches per second until surfaces are wet.

ORNAMENTAL INSECT CONTROL—APHIDS, RED SPIDER MITES, JAPANESE BEETLES, TENT CATERpillars, ARMYWORMS ON ROSES, CHRYSANTHEMUMS, AZALEAS AND SHRUBS.

Hold container 4 feet from plants and spray in a sweeping motion when air is still. Avoid wetting plants. Spray short bursts, especially on new growth. Avoid use in direct sunlight.

DIRECTIONS: SHAKE BEFORE USING. SPRAY ONLY IN UPRIGHT POSITION. LIFT TAB AND PUSH BUTTON TO SPRAY.

CAUTION: Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation. Remove pets, fish bowls and bird cages from rooms being sprayed.

WARNING: Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to sunlight or temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator. Avoid freezing. Keep out of reach of children.

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS: Pyrethrins 0.50%, Technical Piperonyl Butoxide 1.50% (equivalent to 1.20% butyl carbaryl), 6-propylpiperonyl ether and 0.30% related compounds. Petroleum Distillates 5.00%. **INERT INGREDIENTS:** 93.00%.
