Subject: Label change per PR 91-7
Black Flag Flying Insect Killer 91-7D
EPA Reg. No. 475-193
Submission: February 7, 1992

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. The wording "extra strength" is used on the side panel script. To comply with 91-7, this statement must be removed.

2. Provide a label statement of practical treatment providing first aid information for possible human, inhalation, ingestion, and skin and eye contact as appropriate for the subject product.

3. The Precautionary Statements include a section headed by the word "caution". This is considered a human hazard signal word and is inconsistent with the front panel hazard word of "warning". Use only one, appropriate signal word for this product. It should be included on the front panel and immediately following the "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" subheading.

It is understood that this submission constitutes a notification of a new alternate brand name, "Black Flag Flying Insect Killer #91-7D.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

INDOOR USE

To Kill Flying Insects—Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying
Moms, Gnats, Wasps and Hornets Spray insects di-
rectly for quick action. A room can also be cleared of
insects by closing doors and windows and spraying
until the area is thoroughly misted. (Spray in the center
of room 4 feet from walls and objects about 5 to 8
seconds). Vacate room for about 15 minutes and aerate
before re-entering. Sweep up fallen insects.

To Kill Crawling Insects—Roaches and Waterbugs
Spray into cracks and other hiding places such as
baseboards, under sinks, behind refrigerators and
cupboards. Roaches can also be sprayed directly when
flushed out.

For Ants: Spray ants, ant trails, points of entry and nests.

OUTDOOR USE

Area Spray Mist when air is quiet to reduce
Mosquitoes, Flies and Gnats during picnic time. Do
not spray directly on food.
