DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DIRECTIONS: SHAKE BEFORE USING. SPRAY ONLY IN UPRIGHT POSITION. LIFT TAB AND PUSH BUTTON TO SPRAY.

FLYING INSECTS—HOUSEFLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS.

INDOORS: Spray flying insects directly for fast action. To clear a room, close doors and windows. Spray 16-8 seconds from center of room (3 feet from air surfaces) until thoroughly misted. Vacate room for 15 minutes and aerate before re-entering.

OUTDOORS (PATIO USE): Mist areas when air is dull to reduce annoying insects during picnic time. Spray shrubbery and other resting areas. Avoid spraying food.

CRAWLING INSECTS—ROACHES, WATERBUGS, ANTS, SPIDERS. Spray into cracks and crevices to flush out roaches. For quick action spray crawling insects directly. Then also spray ant trails, points of entry and ant nests when possible.

ORNAMENTAL INSECT CONTROL—APHIDS, RED SPIDER MITES, JAPANESE BEETLES, TENT CATERPILLARS, ARMYWORMS ON ROSES, CHRYSANTHEMUMS, AZALEAS AND SHRUBS.

Hold container 4-6 feet from plants and spray in a sweeping motion when air is still. Avoid wetting plants. Spray short bursts, especially on new growth. Avoid use in direct sunlight.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Do not spray on pets or humans. Cover or remove exposed foods. Avoid contamination of cooking utensils and food processing surfaces. Remove pets, fish bowls and bird cages from rooms being sprayed.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is highly toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, meads, marshes, and potholes). Drift from treated areas may be hazardous to organisms in adjacent aquatic sites. Spray ornamental plants from 4 to 6 feet away.

Extremely Flammable PHYSICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Avoid freezing.
