Subject: Application for Pesticide Amendment; Revised Labeling/CSF
Black Flag House & Garden Insect Killer, Formula S
EPA Registration Number 475-214
Submission Dated August 1, 1994

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Three (3) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the product label is enclosed for your records.

1. The *basic Confidential Statement of Formula* (CSF) dated August 1, 1994 is acceptable and has been included in the record for this pesticide product. Note that the % *by weight* (column 13b) for the formulation component *deionized water* should be 59.80, and not 60.00. Submit a corrected CSF to the Agency for the record.

2. Note that it is difficult to correctly review the label as submitted due to the substantially small print size. With regard to future applications submitted to the Agency, ensure that the type size and print quality are legible to the unaided eye.

3. Delete the phrase **PROVEN EFFECTIVE** from the label text.

4. Revise the statement "Do not contaminate water...", which appears in the **ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS** statement to read as follows: Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

5. Expand the statement "Store in a cool area away...", which appears in the **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL** statement to read as follows: Store in a cool, dry area inaccessible to children and pets, and away from heat or open flame.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, ponds or streams. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

SHAKE BEFORE USE. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.

INDOORS

To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Bees, Gnats and Wasps: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up fallen insects.

To Kill Cockroaches, Ants and Crickets: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors around window frames and trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Sawflies, Caterpillars, Fleas and Spiders: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators.

OUTDOORS

To Reduce Annoyance of Mosquitoes, Mosquitoes, Gnats and Small Flying Bees: Spray area infested with these flying insects. Hold container 18-24 inches from shrubs, bushes and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow sweeping motion at the rate of 1 to 3 seconds per cubic yard of space while moving away from the treated areas. To reduce annoyance from these pests, treat open porches and patios in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Ornamental Plant Pests Listed Below:

Caution: When sprayed directly on insects, this spray will kill the insects listed. Caution should be taken when spraying new tender growth on young plants.

WHEN SPRAYING HOLD CAN 18-24 INCHES FROM PLANT

For best results, spray in the evening or on a cloudy day when air is still. Mist the plant lightly. Use a slow sweeping motion. Avoid wetting foliage with spray. Spray roses at the rate of 1 liter per second. For heavy growth spray both sides of rose. Repeat as needed. Do not spray when temperatures exceed 90°F.
