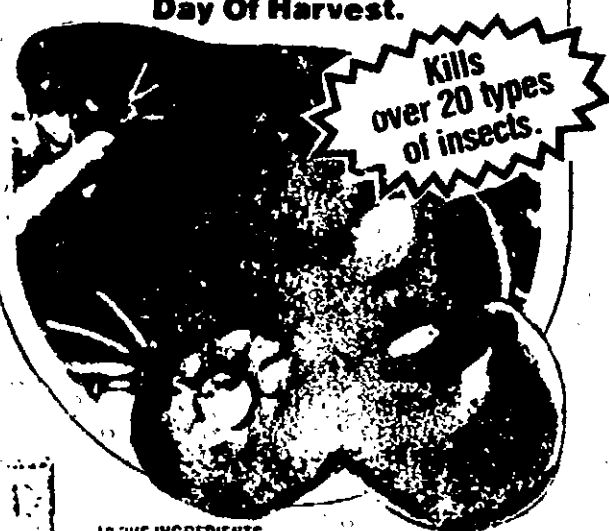

DISPOSAL

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and dispose of in trash. Do not incinerate.

Shake can well before using.
FOR USE ON FRUITS AND VEGETABLES: Hold can at slight downward angle and spray from 4 feet away. Allow fog to drift through plants and reach entire leaves and branches. Also spray undersides of leaves. Contact insects directly whenever possible. Application will be more effective when air is calm. Repeat treatment every 7-10 days for best results. One can will treat three 20' x 30' gardens.
