Black Flag Ant and Roach Killer Spray - the professional strength formula contains ingredients for fast, long-lasting residual killing power. Keeps killing for days when used as directed. Effective against roaches, waterbugs, ants, crickets, centipedes, spiders and earwigs.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Do not store near heat or open flame.
Disposal: Wrap container and dispose of in trash. Do not incinerate.

Directions: Shake can before using. Hold container upright. Point valve opening away from face toward cracks and crevices and other surfaces to be sprayed. Press button firmly. Keep container in upright position: 6 to 12 inches from surfaces and spray at the rate of 1 foot per second or until surfaces are wet. If re-infestations occur, repeat application as necessary. Use only as a surface spray.

APPLICATION WITHIN FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS: (Places other than private residences in which exposed food is held, processed, prepared, or served.)

Food Areas - Application limited to crack and crevice treatment only. Includes areas for food storage, receiving, packing, canning, bottling, food preparing, edible waste storage, and enclosed processing systems. Apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where insects hide. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces. APPLICATIONS OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS OTHER THAN AS A CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ARE NOT PERMITTED.

Serving Areas - Includes facilities where prepared foods are served, such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where food is prepared or held. Apply as a spot treatment to selective surfaces such as baseboards, under elements of construction and into cracks and crevices. Avoid treating surfaces likely to be contacted by food. (Do not apply when facility is in operation or foods are exposed.)

APPLICATION IN NON-FOOD AREAS: (Includes lavatories, locker rooms, machine rooms, offices, boiler rooms, garages, and similar locations). Apply to baseboard areas, around water pipes, surfaces behind and beneath sinks, lockers, tables, pallets and similar areas where insects hide or through which they may enter. Spray bugs directly when they are driven out by the spray. Repeat as necessary.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin. In case of contact, immediately flush skin with plenty of water. Do not apply directly to food. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove any food and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is under way. After spraying in plants, bakeries, and other food processing plants, wash with potable water all equipment, benches, shelving, etc. where exposed food will be handled. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Remove pet and birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.
