MULTI-PURPOSE PREMIXED

Black Flag Super Spray II kills cockroaches, ants, flies and ticks, flies, mosquitoes, spiders, and carpet beetles, and other insects listed below. Keeps killing indoor insects for 28 days.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS

May be harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Keep away from food, feedstuffs and domestic water supplies. Wash thoroughly after handling.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If on skin: In case of contact, remove contaminated clothing and immediately wash skin with plenty of soap and water.

If in eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water.
NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine only by injection is an antidote.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of waste. Apply this product only as specified on this label. This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on plants. Protective information may be obtained from your Cooperative Agricultural Extension Service.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS

Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not store below 32°F.

DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Keep pesticide in original container. Store in a dry, cool place, preferably in a locked storage area.
Product Disposal: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
Container Disposal: Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.

PESTS OUTDOORS

Flies, Mosquitoes: For outdoor use only as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames or wherever these insects may enter the room. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures on porches, in garages, and other places where these insects might aggregate. Repeat as necessary.

Ants, Brown Biting Ticks, Chiggers, Fleas and Earwigs: Outdoors: For treatment of localized infestations of these insects in such areas where there are weeds or brushy non-crop areas, spray infested areas thoroughly. For ants, etc., spray into hills and runways. Repeat applications as infestations warrant and as reinfestation occurs.

Flower, Wrenworts: Use this product to control the pests indicated in the areas below, also by application of the product (1:1) on undiluted spray (0.5% chlorpyrifos). Repeat the treatment as needed. Do not apply sprays of this product in conduits, motor housings, junction and switch boxes or other electrical equipment because of possible shock hazard. Do not use on electrical equipment in buildings. Do not allow spray to contact food, feedstuffs, and water supplies. Thoroughly wash dishes and food handling utensils with soap and water if they become contaminated by application of this product. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces with bare hands. Remove pets and cover fish bowls (tanks) before spraying.

SPRAYER INSTRUCTIONS

Insert the tube into bottle and tighten screw cap. Prime by pumping trigger. Turn nozzle to spray desired, first spray: P-0 in 7.4" stream full right. Use line spray for wetting surfaces. Spray from a distance of one foot. Use jet stream for spraying into cracks and other hiding places for insects. Remove tube and sprayer by spraying water through it at end of each use.

KEEPS KILLING FOR 28 DAYS

INDOORS TO KILL:

Cockroaches, Ants, Chiggers, Clovermites, Silverfish, Spiders and Fleas: Spray in hiding places, cracks, crevices, along baseboards, door and window and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, cabinets, around garbage cans where insects hide and breed. Fleas driven out of hiding places should be Ants: Spray ants, ant trails, ant hills and around doors and windows where necessary.

Carpet Beetles: Thoroughly apply as a spray for spot treatment along base of carpeting, under carpeting, rugs and furniture, in closets and on shelves where these insects are seen or suspected.

Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks: Thoroughly apply as a spray for spot treatment such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along baseboards, window and door frames and infested areas of floor and floor coverings. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced. Bedding after treatment. Also, treat pets with a registered product for control the source of the flea infestation. DO NOT TREAT PETS WITH THIS
