BACK PANEL

Black Flag DRY Flying Insect Killer spray kills bugs fast without wet, messy fall-out. Will not stain furnishings.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Do not store near heat or open flame. Store in cool area away from children.  
Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap and place in trash. Do not incinerate.

Directions: Shake well before using. Spray in upright position. Lift off protective cap. Point valve opening away from your face. Hold can upright at a distance of at least 4 feet from all objects to be sprayed. Press button firmly to spray.

NOTE: Do not spray into or near sources of heat or open flame.

To kill Flying Insects: For flies, mosquitoes, gnats, flying moths, wasps, hornets - Spray directly on flying insects for fast action. To clear a room, close windows and doors; spray upward with waving motion (6 or 7 seconds for average 10' by 12' room). Vacate room for at least 15 minutes. Then let air circulate before re-entering.

To kill Crawling Insects: For German cockroaches, waterbugs, roaches, earwigs, spiders: Spray directly on insects where possible. Thoroughly spray in hiding places such as cracks, crevices, around pipes, under refrigerators and baseboards. Repeat as necessary.
