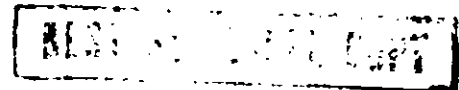

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS.

CAUTION: USE ONLY WHEN AREA TO BE TREATED IS VACATED BY HUMANS AND PETS. Hazard if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists. Do not apply directly to food. In the home, all food-processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Remove pets and cover fish aquariums and delicate plants before spraying. Remove all motor vehicles before using in garages.

Do not use in the edible product areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants, or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or served. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS: Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator. Insecticides may soften some asphalt or no-wax floors. If used directly over asphalt or no-wax tile, place in large pan. Newspaper should be spread on the floor for several feet around area of release. Do not operate clothes dryers while fogging.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT.

If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting. Note to Physician: May present aspiration hazard.

If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If on skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. If in eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal. Container Disposal: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture. Pesticide Disposal: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

PREPARATION: Cover or remove exposed loads, dishes, and food-handling equipment. All food-processing surfaces should be covered immediately prior to treatment or thoroughly cleaned after treatment. Close doors and windows. Open cabinets and doors within the treatment area. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all open flames except pilot light. Place at least 6 feet away from pilot light. Fogger should be placed on floor in the middle of the room. Place newspapers under the can to prevent marring surface. Note instructions concerning no-wax floors and motor vehicles above.

USE: One 12 oz. can for each 12,000 Cu. Ft. of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. If free flow of mist is not assured in certain areas, there should be an increase of airing-out time.

1. Place on a section of newspaper on floor in center of room to be fogged. 2. Remove red Fog-Lock Actuator Cap, then remove white cap. Place red Actuator Cap with top hole resting on nozzle. 3. Hold at arm's length pointing can AWAY from face and eyes (container sprays straight up). Press red Fog-Lock Actuator Cap down firmly with thumb and index finger until a lock over upper part of can. 4. Place fogger upright on newspaper, leave room, and close door. 5. After airing Fogger, leave house at once. Keep treated area closed for at least 2 hours. Upon re-entry, open all doors and windows and allow to air for 1 hour.

USE: One 12 oz. can for each 12,000 Cu. Ft. (One 5 oz. can for each 5,000 Cu. Ft.) of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. If free flow of mist is not assured in certain areas, there should be an increase of airing-out time.

1. Hold can at arm's length, point AWAY from face and eyes (container sprays straight up). 2. To actuate fogger depress tab until it clicks in locked position. 3. Place fogger upright on a section of newspaper on floor in center of room to be fogged. Leave room, close door, and leave house at once. 4. Keep treated area closed for at least 2 hours. Upon re-entry, open all doors and windows and allow to air for 1 hour.
