BACK PANEL

The dry Holiday Household Insect Fogger has a special dry formula system that kills bugs where they hide. Remember to use Holiday everywhere you have a bug problem, as it kills: Adult and pre-adult fleas, brown dog ticks, roaches, ants, silverfish, waterbugs, spiders, crickets, houseflies, mosquitoes, small flying moths, wasps, and hornets.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Preparation: Open any cabinet doors and drawers to allow maximum kill in all areas where insects can hide and breed. Close doors and windows and shut off fans and air conditioning to maximize killing power. Important: Follow precautions below for extinguishing all flames and shutting off gas supply to pilot lights in areas to be treated. Do not remain in treated area and ventilate before re-occupying.

Use: Shake well before using. Place can on newspaper on floor in center of room to be fogged. With can at arm's length, direct spray away from face. (Container sprays straight up.) Depress tab until it clicks into locked position. Exit immediately. Keep area closed for 4 hours before ventilating and reoccupying.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in cool area, away from heat or flame, and away from children.

Disposal: Replace cap and discard containers in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash contaminated skin promptly with soap and water. For eyes, flush with plenty of water.
