The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

As new labels are prepared, delete the term "related compounds" from the label ingredients declaration. Unless otherwise substantiated, these isomers should be considered inert. If the "related compounds" are determined to be active, they should be incorporated in the declaration for the active ingredient and not distinguished as "related compounds" or "other isomers".

Also at next printing, you may delete the statement "d-cis + d-trans" from the label ingredient declaration for sumithrin. Refer to the Sumithrin Registration Standard if further guidance is required.

It is also understood that this submission constitutes a notification of a new alternate brand name, "Black Flag Flying Insect Killer #91-7A" for this product.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE BEFORE USE. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.

To Kill Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths, Gnats and Wasps: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before reentry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects.

To Kill Cockroaches, Ants and Crickets: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspect of harbouring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Carpet Beetles: Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Exposed Forms of Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-Toothed Grain Beetles, and Rice Weevils: Find and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Sowbugs, Centipedes, Firebrats and Spiders: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harbouring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators.

To Kill Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks: Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Place fresh bedding in pet's quarters after spray has dried. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray animals. Pets should be treated with a registered flea and tick control product before reentering treated areas.

To treat carpets, spray at the rate of one square foot per second. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
