General: Use Residual Spray of Black Flag Liquid Crawling Insect Killer as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control cockroaches, waterbugs, silverfish, ticks, fleas and other insects listed below. Apply this product as a coarse spray to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as needed. Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

For Spot Treatment in homes, kennels and commercial buildings:

To Kill Cockroaches, Ants, Crickets, Silverfish, Spiders and Sowbugs at the sites listed above: Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas at the sites listed above: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do Not Spray Pets With This Product.

For Crack and Crevice Treatment in homes, kennels and commercial buildings:

To Kill Ants, Roaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, Earwigs, Brown Dog Ticks, Fleas, Carpet Beetles and Dermestids at the sites listed above: Apply diluted spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Equipment capable of delivering a pin stream should be used in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where the above listed insect hide.

For restaurants and food processing facilities: Follow directions for Spot Treatment and Crack and Crevice Treatment to kill the above listed insects.  
 APPLICATIONS OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS OTHER THAN AS A CRACK AND CREVICE AND SPOT TREATMENT, ARE NOT PERMITTED.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

Flies and Mosquitoes: Use only out of doors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas (such as under eaves) or porches, patios and garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when necessary.
