- e. Under **Hazards to Humans...**, revise the statement "In the home do not..." as follows:

In the home, cover all food handling surfaces and cover or remove all food and cooking utensils, or wash thoroughly after treatment.

- f. Under the heading "General" add the following precautions:

For Spot Application Only. Do not use as a Space Spray.

- h. Delete **Professional Strength** from the labeling. Words or phrases implying that a product possesses unique characteristics because of its composition are not acceptable.

- i. Since your data matrix does not give a dielectric breakdown voltage, you must add the following to the use directions:

Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

- j. We assume from the labeling this product is intended for use by homeowners and thus will contain a pump spray device or spray head attachment for application directly from the original container. The Agency discourages marking of pesticides for indoor use to the general public unless they are ready to be applied, i.e., aerosols, pump sprays, etc., from the original container. Please clarify.

- k. Either delete the direction for creak and crevice treatment or explain how the homeowner applies the spray in small amounts using a stream-like spray. Does the spray head have different nozzle openings to vary the type of spray? It appears these instruction are geared towards commercial applicators and should be deleted.

3. The one year storage and stability data are acceptable and satisfy the ambient one year storage stability requirement of 40 CFR 158.190, Guideline Requirement No. 63-17.

4. Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

General: Use this residual spray as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control cockroaches, waterbugs, silverfish, ticks, fleas and other insects listed below. Apply this product as a coarse spray to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as needed.

FOR SPOT TREATMENT:

To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Spiders, Sowbugs, Carpet Beetles, Scorpions and Black Widow Spiders: Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do Not Spray Pets With This Product. Pets should be treated with a registered flea and tick product before reentering area.

FOR CRACK AND CREVICE:

To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, Earwigs, Brown Dog Ticks, Fleas, Carpet Beetles, Dermestids, Scorpions, and Black Widow Spiders:

Apply spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. A stream-like spray should be used in points between different elements of construction, between appliances and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where the above listed insects hide.

Care should be taken to avoid introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

OUT OF DOORS:

Flies and Mosquitoes: Use only out of doors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting places (such as under eaves) or porches, patios and garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment as necessary.
