HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

To apply to face, spray on hands and rub on. Repeat as needed. For ticks and chiggers, also apply liberally to shoe tops, socks, and around openings in clothing.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
