

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

To kill flies, mosquitoes, gnats, small flying moths: Close all doors and windows and thoroughly spray all parts of the room particularly toward the ceiling so as to fill the room with mist. Keep nozzle three feet from surfaces. Keep room closed for 10-15 minutes after treatment. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat treatment as necessary. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

To kill Wasps: Application should be made in late evening when the wasps are at rest. Spraying into hiding and breeding places contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat treatment as necessary.

To kill ants and roaches: Attempt to contact as many insects as possible directly and thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. For the control of ants pay special attention to the treatment of doors, windows and ant trails. Repeat treatment as necessary.

To kill crickets: Spray thoroughly behind stoves, refrigerators, under cabinets, in food storage areas and especially in closets. Attempt to contact insects directly whenever possible. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed.

**WARNING:** Contents under pressure. Store upright in a cool place (not over 120°F). Do not place on hot surface. Do not puncture can. Never throw in fire or incinerator. May stain finish surfaces if sprayed too closely.
