Precautionary Statements - Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION:

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush skin with plenty of water.

Do not use in commercial food processing or preparation areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces, exposed food and utensils should be removed during treatment or thoroughly washed before use.

Remove pots, pans and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS:

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130 F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE — GENERAL CLASSIFICATION:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash with caution.

HOW TO USE:

Hold container upright. Apply in short bursts.

To Kill Flies, Mosquitos, Small Flying Moths and Gnats: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects.

To Kill Cockroaches, Ants and Crickets: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, cracks, under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, and other areas where these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill and destroy them, sweep up and destroy fallen insects and other insects of the room.

To Kill Carpet Beetles: Thoroughly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both under and over side of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rug and carpet should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, and other areas where these insects are found or suspected.

To Kill Exposed Forms of Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-Toothed Grain Beetles, and Rice Weevils: Find and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Sowbugs, Centipedes, Firebrats and Spiders: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, cracks, under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators.

To Kill Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks: Remove and destroy red pet bedding. Spray sleeping quarters and pets around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, and all areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray animals. Put pet bedding in pet's quarters after spray has dried. Animals should be treated with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to enter treated area.
