**ANT & ROACH SPRAY**

This formulation gives rapid kill of crawling insects as listed below including those resistant to certain chlorinated hydrocarbon and phosphite insecticides. Spray residues kill insects 1-2 weeks indoors after the spray deposit has dried.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS  
 HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**CAUTION:** May be harmful if swallowed inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. In case of contact immediately flush skin and eyes with plenty of water. Wash thoroughly with soap and warm water after handling. If poisoning occurs, get prompt medical aid.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

- IF IN EYES:** Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
- IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Remove contaminated clothing. Wash skin with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
- IF INHALED:** Remove to fresh air if effects occur and call physician.
- IF SWALLOWED:** Get medical attention immediately.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Propoxur is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine by injection is an antidote.

Do not use in commercial food processing or preparation areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

**PHYSICAL HAZARDS**

Flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**Storage:** Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.  
**Disposal:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collector.

**General:** Spray surface to wetting. Point spray away from people, plants and pets. Do not use as a space spray. Use only on surfaces for spot treatment. Avoid excessive wetting of plastic, rubber and asphalt surfaces such as tiles and floor coverings.

**Indoor Use:** ANTS, COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, SCORPIONS, SAWTOOTHED GRAIN BEETLES (exposed stage), WATERBUGS. Spray into cracks, crevices, around baseboards and other places where these insects hide. Apply behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves and in and around waste containers. Repeat as needed. Do not spray foodstuffs or house plants. For ants, spray trails and places where ants enter premises. Do not allow children to contact treated surfaces until surfaces are completely dry.

**BROWN DOG TICKS:** Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as needed. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment of pet areas. Additionally, treat pets with EPA approved product registered for direct application to pets. Do not spray on animals.
