Precautionary Statements - Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION:

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin. In case of contact, immediately flush skin with plenty of water.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in cool area away from heat or open flame.
Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

To Protect Woolen Articles: Brush woolen articles clean, air and remove persistent spots and stains by dry cleaning. Before spraying garment, spray a small hidden area of fabric to determine if staining will occur. Holding dispenser at least one foot from garment, spray thoroughly. Treated articles should be put in darkened closet or other darkened storage area. For best protection clean and spray insides of closets or storage units for 30-40 seconds before putting treated articles away. This will kill the larvae and adults of carpet beetles and closet moths. Treatments should be repeated every six months or as needed. Dry clean treated clothes before wearing.
