Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

C A U T I O N

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling.

Do not apply directly to food. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove any food or food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is underway. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before reuse. Cover exposed food.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated areas until surfaces are dry.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine is antidotal only by injection.

Environmental Hazards

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning equipment or disposal of wastes.

Physical Hazards

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

General: Use as a spot treatment to control cockroaches, waterbugs, silverfish, ticks, fleas and other insects listed below. Apply this product to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet.

Spot Treatment: TO KILL ANTS, ROACHES, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, SOWBUGS, SPIDERS and EARWIGS: Spray into cracks, crevices, around baseboards, and other places where these insects hide. Apply behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, and in and around waste containers. Contact directly as many insects as possible. For ants, spray trails and places where ants enter.

premises. Repeat as necessary for control.

TO KILL BROWN DOG TICKS AND FLEAS: Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters after spray has dried. Do not spray animals. Treat pets with a product registered for application to animals to control the source of the flea infestation.

TO KILL CARPET BEETLES AND DERMESTIDS: Spray along baseboards, edges of carpeting, under carpets and rugs, under furniture, in closets, on shelving, and in other places of harborage. Repeat as necessary.

Caution should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

Applications may be made within food handling establishments. This includes but is not limited to, restaurants, grocery stores, bakeries, bottling plants, canneries, and grain mills.

Apply as a coarse spray to localized areas in and around both food and non food areas. Treat where insects are found or normally occur, including dark corners of rooms and closets; floor drains; cracks and crevices in walls; along and behind baseboards; beneath and behind sinks, stoves, refrigerators, refrigerator units, and cabinets; and around plumbing and other utility installations.

In food handling establishments use only as a spot treatment. Spot treatment may encompass crack and crevice treatments by applying small amounts of material directly into openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases, or which occur at points between different elements of construction, or between equipment and floors.
