2. Make the labeling change listed below before you release the product for shipment:

- a. Add the phrase, "EPA Registration No. 475-349."
- b. Under the heading Statement of Practical Treatment add:

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.
IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth. Get medical attention.

- d. Revise Precautionary Statements as follows:

"Harmful if absorbed through skin or inhaled. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before smoking or eating. Avoid contamination of feed . . ."

- e. On the front panel delete ". . . and many other pests." Vague and non-specific terminology is not allowed. You may use, ". . . and many similar pests."
- f. Add a footnote to the inert ingredients indicating:
 *Contains petroleum distillates
- g. The label is not clear as to where the product can be used. We assume it is for residential use thus on the front panel add:
 "For Use In and Around the Home"
- h. Include the claim Deer Ticks in parenthesis following the general tick claim, i.e.:
 Ticks (including deer tick)
- i. Delete the paragraph beginning "May be used on plants as well . . ." since it is redundant with the first and third paragraphs under For the Control of Garden Insects.
- j. On the front and side panels add ornamental before garden insects, i.e., ". . . residential and ornamental insects"; ". . . Control of Ornamental and Garden Insects."

3. Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Remove protective cap, hold container upright and spray from a distance of 12 to 15 inches. Remove birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

INDOORS:

Houseflies, Fruit Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, Hornets, Bees, Black Flies, Skipper Flies, Blow Flies and Small Flying Moths: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep nozzle in constant motion. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and discard fallen insects. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Cockroaches, Waterbugs, Palmetto Bugs, Silverfish, Firebrats, Crickets, Scorpions, Spiders, Millipedes, Centipedes, Sowbugs and Pillbugs: Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray whenever possible. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Ants: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on Ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

Carpet Beetles: Spray directly on Beetles, floors, baseboards, shelves and carpets. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Bedbugs: Spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seams. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Treat baseboards, moldings and floors. Repeat treatment as necessary.

To control *Clothes Moths* and *Carpet Beetles* on wool and other proteinaceous fibers: Remove infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly, and air for several hours in sunlight, if possible. Apply spray liberally to empty chests, closets, bureaus and other storages directing the spray into cracks, joints and crevices. After airing, infested articles may be

treated by spraying lightly, keeping from fabric to avoid staining

OUTDOORS:

Point spray nozzle away from downward angle. For best results, allow a few minutes for product to dry if breeze is blowing.

PESTS OUTSIDE SURFACE OF building infestation due to *Ants, Earwigs, Millipedes and Sowbugs*. Direct spray toward bush or entrance, up to a height of 2 to 3 feet to outside surfaces of buildings, window frames, eaves, porches, etc. Repeat treatment as necessary.

FLYING INSECTS: *Flies, Mosquitoes, Moths, Hornets and Yellow Jackets.* Direct spray toward bush or area, 6 feet away. Give special attention to garbage cans and compost piles.

CRAWLING INSECTS: *Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Centipedes, Millipedes, Spiders, Silverfish, Firebrats, and Sowbugs.* Infested surface of patio or plank as possible. Also spray legs of insects. Spray ant hills for best control.

Ants, Lone Star Ticks, Crickets. Spray thoroughly to infestation in bush or spray freely around ant trails and

For the Control of Garden *Dahlias, asters and other ornamentals* hit by spray, as well as *Whiteflies, Spiders, Red Mites and Leafhoppers.*

May be used on plants, as well as small gardens and for spot treatments to prevent spreading in lawns.
