Apply when air is calm using power dusting equipment or aircraft. Apply 25 pounds per acre at the first sign of infestation and repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals as needed to achieve control but observe use limits given for specific crops.

### RECOMMENDATIONS

COLE CROPS (Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Kohlrabi)—Cabbage looper, imported cabbage worm. Do not apply within 3 days of harvest.

LETTUCE—Alfalfa looper (Pacific Coast stales) cabbage looper, imported cabbage worm, learnopper. Do not apply within 4 days of harvest.

SPINACH—Cabbage looper, leafhoppers. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.
