STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS (cont.)

Liquid phases may separate at lower temperatures. Warm or store at higher temperatures and mix thoroughly to recombine liquid phases and assure uniformity before use.

OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING USE PRECAUTIONS

Read all label directions before using. Use only for claims listed and only as specified on this label.

In case of breakage cover immediately with sufficient garden soil or any other absorbent material to thoroughly soak up liquid. Sweep up area and bury waste in a safe place. Wash area thoroughly with soap and water containing household ammonia.

Fish and Wildlife Cautions: This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Keep out of lakes, streams and ponds. Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Do not use without dilution. Dilute by mixing as directed below in the proper amount of water, to give complete coverage with the type of equipment used. Wash out hose proportioner jar or other container after use. Flush out and discard this bottle when empty. Store unused insecticide in cabinet away from children.

RECOMMENDATIONS

For control of **Chinch Bugs** on **Lawn or Turf**, first wet lawn thoroughly.

If you apply this material with a hose proportioner, add 1/3 pint TRITHION 2 in 1-quart hose proportioner jar and fill with water. Attach hose and sprinkle 500 square feet. Use at least 15 to 25 gallons of water per 500 square feet of lawn. Repeat this operation until your entire lawn is covered.

To apply with a sprinkling can, put 1 tablespoonful of TRITHION 2 in the sprinkling can, fill can with water, and apply evenly to 50 square feet (an area 5 x 10 feet). Do not permit children or domestic animals on lawn until treated area is completely dry.
