**LAWN AND TURF: CHINCH BUGS** — Apply 7 pounds of this material on 2,000 square feet (40' x 50') of lawn. Most garden fertilizer spreaders when set on number used for small grass seed will correctly distribute this material. Refer to suggested spreader setting table given below.

Immediately after application, drench with water or sprinkle thoroughly. Do not allow children or pets on treated lawn until completely dry.
