DIRECTIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS FOR POST-FLOOD, POST-EMERGENCE
USE ON RICE

(WATER SEEDED OR DRILLED RICE)

FOR USE ON RICE TO CONTROL BARNYARDGRASS (WATERGRASS) (ECHINOCHLOA spp.)
DAYFLOWER (COMMELINA spp.), AND SUPPRESSION OF ANNUAL SEDGES (CYPERUS spp.)
AND SPIKERUSH (ELEOCHARIS spp.).

STANDARD TREATMENT: RICE MUST BE ESTABLISHED AT THE TIME OF APPLICA-
TION.

BARNYARDGRASS (WATERGRASS), DAYFLOWER, ANNUAL SEDGES AND SPIKERUSH
MUST NOT BE MORE THAN 5 INCHES HIGH. BARNYARDGRASS, ANNUAL SEDGES
AND SPIKERUSH MUST BE AT LEAST $\frac{2}{3}$ SUBMERGED. DAYFLOWER MUST BE
COMPLETELY SUBMERGED. FLOODS SHOULD BE MAINTAINED AT THESE DEPTHS
UNTIL THE DAYFLOWER OR WATERGRASS DIES OR UNTIL THE ANNUAL SEDGES
AND SPIKERUSH IS SUPPRESSED. USUALLY 10 DAYS FOR GRASS AND THREE
WEEKS FOR DAYFLOWER, ANNUAL SEDGES, AND SPIKERUSH.

RATE: APPLY 20-30 POUNDS PER ACRE.

OR

IN EMERGENCY SITUATIONS: ORDRAM MAY BE USED FOR SUPPRESSION (STOPPING
NORMAL DEVELOPMENT) OF BARNYARDGRASS OVER 5 INCHES TALL AND UNDER
12 INCHES TALL. FLOOD WATER MUST BE MAINTAINED AT A 4 TO 6 INCH
DEPTH UNTIL SUPPRESSION OCCURS.

RATE: APPLY AT 30 POUNDS PER ACRE.
