



INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

PREPARATION

Prepare the soil for seeding according to good agricultural practice.

APPLICATION AND SOIL INCORPORATION

PREFAR must be thoroughly incorporated to a depth of one to two inches before planting. Spray equipment should be carefully calibrated before use and checked frequently during application to insure that nozzles are free from clogging and are delivering a uniform spray pattern. Apply uniformly at the recommended rate of PREFAR in 20-100 gallons per acre. Apply to well-worked soil that is moist to permit thorough incorporation.

Wash spray equipment and containers. Discharge into a pit in non-crop lands located away from crops and supplies.

USE EMPTY METAL CONTAINERS. DO NOT REUSE GLASS.

Crop	When to Apply	Dosage — Quarts/ Broadcast Acre	Remarks
LETTUCE (Head or Leaf)	Pre-plant	5-6	For control of all weeds listed. <i>Apply and incorporate on bed tops with power-driven tillers.</i>
CUCUMBERS SUMMER SQUASH CANTALOUPE MUSKMELONS WATERMELONS CRENSHAW MELONS PERSIAN MELONS	Pre-plant	5-6 OR	For control of all weeds listed. On bedded crops apply and incorporate on bed tops with power-driven tillers. On flat planted crops, apply (in bands or broadcast) and then incorporate with equipment which will result in thorough incorporation.
COTTON	Pre-plant	2	For control of annual grasses in Southwestern States. Use only on light sandy soils.

Then thoroughly disc the Prefert
into the soil.

OR

Apply to the flat soil surface before furrowing (listing) for the pre-planting irrigation and then continue with normal practices.

Apply after furrowing (listing) and before the pre-planting irrigation. Incorporate with a sectioned, rolling cultivator.

FOLLOW WITH PRE-PLANTING IRRIGATION

Apply after the pre-planting irrigation and before the final seed bed preparation.
