

Supplementary Labeling for
Corn Covering New Insect Additions

Corn (Field, Sweet and Popcorn)

- A. Band Application for Control of Northern and Western Corn Rootworms, Seed Corn Beetle and Seed Corn Maggot (Recommended for seed corn beetle and seed corn maggot in the Central and Midwestern corn growing areas only):

Apply 3-3/4 to 5 pounds Dyfonate 20·G per acre in a 6 to 8 inch band over corn rows 38 to 40 inches apart (equivalent to 4.5 to 6 ounces of Dyfonate 20·G per 1,000 linear feet of row based on 40 inch row spacing). Incorporate into the top 1/2 to 1 inch of soil, by making application ahead of the press wheels, or by use of special covering devices, or by dragging a short length of chain behind the press wheels.

- B. Broadcast Application for Control of Symphylans and Wireworms:

Apply 20 pounds (for wireworms) or 10 pounds (for symphylans) Dyfonate 20·G per acre, prior to planting and incorporate into the soil by discing.
