## DIRECTIONS FOR USE (CONTINUED)

Spray method(grubs and hornflies): To prepare the spray, dilute each volume of PROLATE 1E with 49 volumes of water and stir vigorously. Apply the fresh mixture as a high-pressure spray directly to wet the skin (not just the hair) of each animal to "run-off". Use about 1 gal. of the diluted spray for adult animal. Lesser amounts will permit run-off for younger animals. Pour-on method (cattle grubs):

Dilute 1 volume of Prolate 1E with

2 volumes of water by slowly adding the water to the insecticide concentrate while stirring. Apply 1 fl.oz. of the fresh ly diluted mixture per 100 lbs. of body wt. (to a max. of 8 oz. per head) down the center line of the animal's back. One gal. of PROLATE 1E makes 3 gals. of pour-on solution and will treat:

196 animals weighing 200 pounds
131 animals weighing 300 pounds
98 animals weighing 400 pounds
78 animals weighing 500 pounds
65 animals weighing 600 pounds
56 animals weighing 700 pounds
49 animals weighing 800 pounds or over.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

A single spray or pour-on treatment with PROLATE IE will control cattle grubs; for hornfly control repeat as necessary but not more often than every 7 days. Hornfly control is affected by weather, population pressure and other factors which cause periods of fly activity to vary. For optimum cattle grub control, it is important to treat as soon as possible after the heel fly season, before the grub larvae reach the gullet or spinal canal as the rapid kill of large numbers of larvae in these tissues may cause toxic side effects. her; fly season in your area.
